## **Human Geography Unit Project**

For this project, you have the option of working individually or with a partner. If you choose to work with a partner, you must also submit a write-up indicating the responsibilities of each individual. The grade assigned to the project will not necessarily be the same for each partner.

- 1) Identify 3 criteria that may measure a country's standard of living. Examples: Birth rate, Death rate, Literacy rate, GNP (wealth), Life expectancy, Infant mortality rate, Number of doctors per population, etc.
- 2) Select 10 countries for which you will collect the data.

- 3) Display the data for each country you have selected on a graph or chart.
- 4) Label the 10 countries on the World Map provided.
- 5) Evaluate the data collected for each country. Use the following criteria:

5 =excellent standard

4 = above average

3 = average

2 = below average

1 = extremely poor standards

6) Rank-order the selected countries according to the sum of the 3 possible scores.

13-15 = high standard of living

10-12 = above average

7-9 = average

4-6 = below average

1-3 = extremely poor standards

7) Colour your map as per the rankings. Include a legend.

8) Choose 2 countries from your list of 10.

One country should have at least an above average standard of living. The other country should have a below average or extremely poor standard of living rating.

- 9) Answer the following questions:
  - a. Describe the standard of living in each country.
  - b. What are the 3 criteria you selected? Are these the best indicators? Why or why not?
  - c. Will the standard of living for each country improve in the future? Explain in detail.
  - d. Do you think the countries will ever be close to having a similar standard of living? Explain in detail.
- 10) Identify the less-developed of your two previously selected countries Create a brochure which solicits foreign aid for your country. Include a summary of:
  - > The main obstacles to development
  - > A proposal of what you would do with aid money

Use creativity and visual elements to create an attention-grabbing and persuasive brochure.

- 11) Write a 150+ word composition explaining:
  - a. What you learned from this project
  - b. Which part of this project was the most valuable, and why
- 12) Put everything together in an organized and professional-looking booklet. Include a cover page, title, and table of contents.
